COATS

We have noticed a number of children arriving at school without a coat or jumper in this cold, wet and windy weather. Please ensure your child is appropriately dressed now that the weather is turning colder.

SAFEGUARDING

The designated safeguarding leads at St. Peter's are myself and Mrs Brewster. Please speak to one of us in confidence if you have any concerns.

CAMERAS ON SANDY LANE/PARKING

A reminder that City Of Doncaster Council has installed a camera enforcement system to use outside a number of schools in the Borough, including St. Peter's. This is designed to promote a safer environment around the school gates by reducing congestion, which in turn improves air quality.

If you do need to drive, remember to use the large car park outside the bowling alley and Vue Cinema. We ask you to be respectful of local residents, and avoid parking in the local streets and at the Aircraft Museum. There have been a number of incidents of inconsiderate and dangerous parking.

If you walk a dog to school please can you not congregate around the main pedestrian gate as this can cause a blockage at busy times. We also are aware some parents and children not comfortable around dogs and this causes issues for them when they have to pass by closely.
