ONLINE SAFETY

Staff are increasingly concerned about the online activities of some of our children via gaming and social media. Over the year, we will continue to educate our children, but please ensure you put appropriate limits and boundaries in place.

South Yorkshire Police have recently contacted all schools in the area to raise concerns around inappropriate internet use by children as young as four. Last year 11 % of the referrals they received were for safeguarding concerns regarding online safety. In the first half of this year they have seen a huge increase with 26% having been received in the first half of this year (Jan - Jun) alone.
