Dear Parents

PARENTS EVENING

CONTACT WITH CLASS TEACHERS

Could I ask that if you have any concerns or queries, these should first of all be directed to your child's class teacher, who are always available before and after school. However, please be mindful that at the start of the school day, they are seeing children into class, and at the end of the day, they have to ensure that every child is collected safely. They cannot therefore always be seen immediately, and we ask you to be patient at this busy time of day.
